SCOPE:	This course is designed to provide local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective LOFR on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable students to process and apply their new knowledge.
PURPOSE:	This ICS position is responsible for serving as the incident's point of contact for coordinating with agency representatives from assisting and cooperating agencies. Reports to the Incident Commander and is a member of the Command Staff.
WHO SHOULD ATTEND:	NIMS ICS Position Specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to functional, support, or unit leader positions on USFA or other Type III All-Hazards Incident Management Teams (AHIMT), or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions.
NIMS COMPLIANCE:	This course is NIMS compliant and meets the NIMS Baseline Training requirements for Type 3 All-Hazards Incident Management Team.
PRIMARY AUDIENCE:	Persons involved with emergency planning, response or recovery efforts.
PRE-REQUISITES:	ICS-100, 200, 300, IS 700 & IS 800 Note: Completion of the ICS 400 course is highly recommended for all Position Specific training classes
